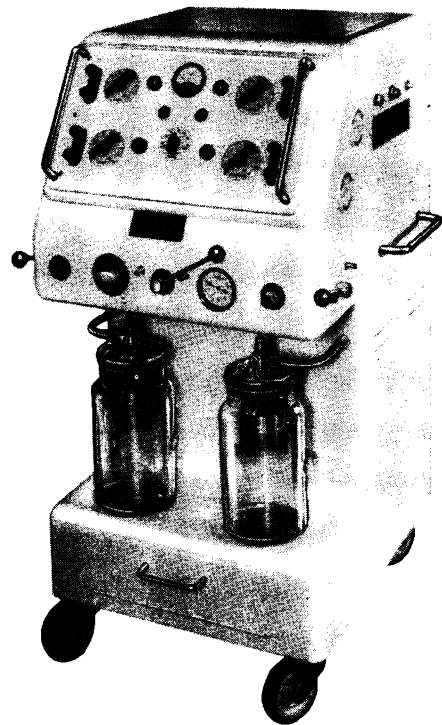

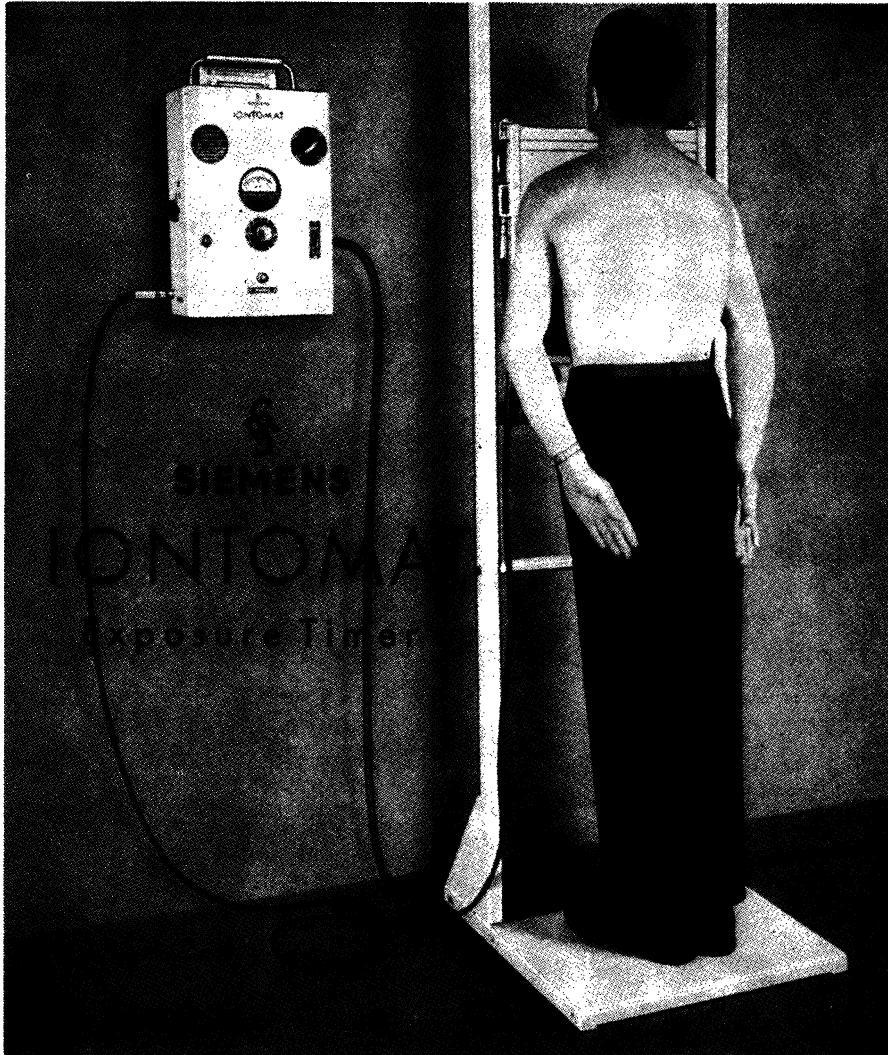

# Automatic Exposure Control by Ionisation Current

**THERAPAS** is a modified form of P.A.S. that is more than an alternative.

P.A.S. was originally combined with isoniazid or streptomycin in order to delay the emergence of resistant strains of *M. tuberculosis*. **Therapas does this, too.** It is as effective as P.A.S. for this purpose. Similar in structure to P.A.S., it is converted to it in the body (1). P.A.S. combined with isoniazid or strepto-

mycin is effective against *M. tuberculosis*. **Therapas is more so.** It is not merely an adjunct, but has a therapeutic activity *per se* (2). In combined therapy it is highly effective (3). P.A.S., unfortunately, is poorly tolerated. **Therapas is not so,** and provides a welcome alternative. It has a slightly sweet, not unpleasant taste. Patients who dislike P.A.S. should be tried on Therapas.
