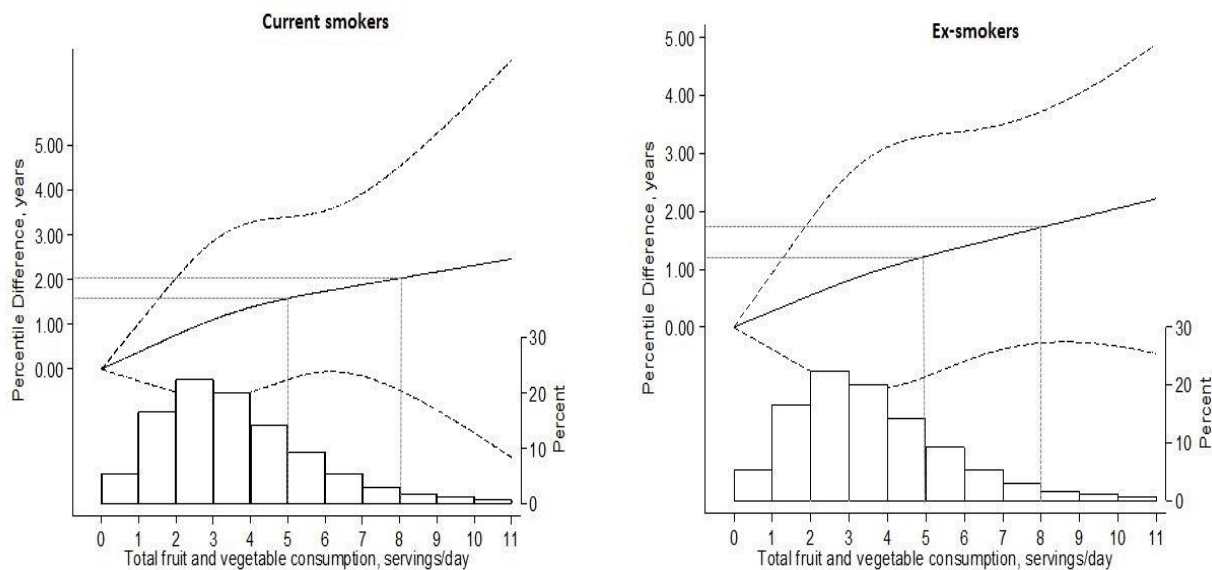

Supplementary Fig. 1. The percentile differences (differences in years by which 5% of the cohort experienced the event) of chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) incidence as a function of total fruit and vegetable consumption among current and ex-smokers. The solid curve represents percentile difference and dashed-dotted lines represent 95% confidence intervals. The distribution of total fruit and vegetable consumption is presented at the bottom of the figure as a histogram.
