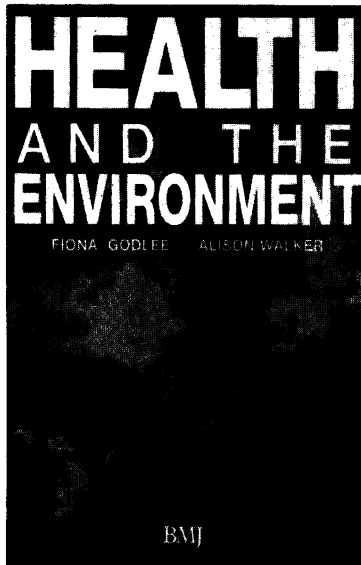


Urgent need for action

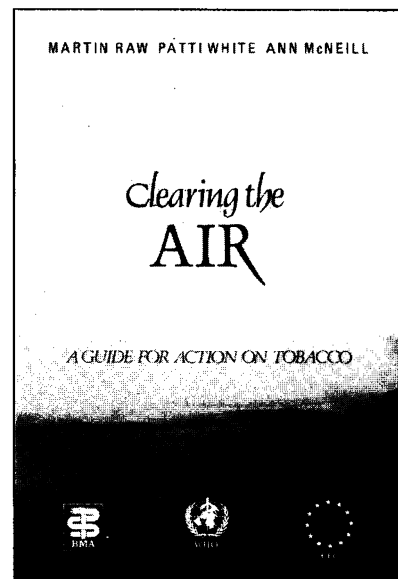

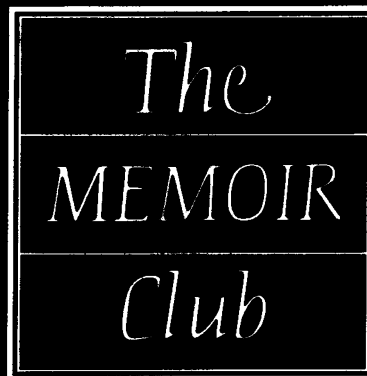
